

CALL THE POLICE

Don't try to tackle your truck accident on your own. Contact the Ohio State Highway Patrol or local police and ask them to investigate your accident.

GET THE FACTS Make sure you get the following

information from the truck driver:



Truck driver's full name, plus:

- **✓** Address
- ✓ Phone number
- ✓ Insurance policy number
- **✓** Address

Trucking company name, plus:

- ✓ Phone number



Photographs of your accident can make a

TAKE PICTURES

dramatic difference in the outcome of your case. Make sure you get photos of:


Damage to vehicles

- Skid marks (or absence of them)
- Nearby street signs
- Speed limit signs



TALK TO WITNESSES If someone saw something, his or her testimony

could help you build a strong case with the insurance company in your favor. If there are witnesses, make sure you get their:



✓ Full name


what happened as soon as possible. The more information you have about your accident, the better.

While your memory is fresh, write down exactly
